*Please pray over your lesson weekly and ask that God will give you wisdom, joy, passion, enthusiasm and the right words that your group of children needs to hear.

*In order to provide continuity in our Sunday/Wednesday lessons, please follow the curriculum as closely as possible and adapt to fit the needs of the children in your classroom.

* I will prepare your supplies for you weekly. They will be in a tub ready for you in the classroom.

If you are in need of something that is not in your lesson or if you run out of classroom supplies, just let me know a week in advance and I will have it for you (this includes snacks). Please feel free to add your own great ideas to the curriculum as well.

*Please commit to arriving for your class 20 minutes early in order to get your supplies out. This will allow you to set up centers if needed. It is always good just to mentally be there and be set by the time your first child arrives. And as I am sure you already know, greet them with tons of love, smiles, and an enthusiasm for discovering God's word together!!

The following are quick and easy closing/cleaning procedures that are in place for each class:

- 1) At the end of class, please stand at your classroom door and release children 2nd grade and under to a parent or responsible adult that has the corresponding sticker.
- 2) Use the Dust Buster to vacuum up any food or craft messes on the floor.
- 3) Wipe down the tables and chairs.
- 4) Return materials to the counter in the workroom.
- 5) Turn off classroom lights.
- 6) Shut and lock classroom door.

Adult classes on Sunday morning will be dismissing at 9:45, so that you and your helper will have time to clean and tidy up before going into worship.

We need to take pride in our classrooms and keep our building looking nice and welcoming for our wonderful Wee School ministry that meets during the week in these classrooms.
